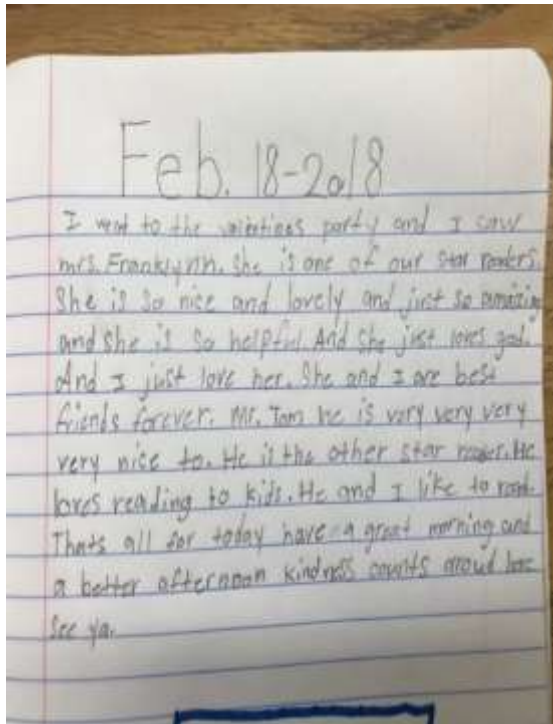
The Choir prepared the February 20 dinner, and proceeds of \$260.00 went for the Music Department.
