### **Sermon Recap**

- The Samaritan woman was excluded from her community because of a particular social stigma.
- Ironically, at the end of the story, she is the one who bears good news to her village that brings about transformation in her community.
- Not was the Samaritan woman incomplete because she felt unworthy or unwanted, but her community was incomplete without her.
- It is our responsibility to make sure that everyone around us knows that they are welcome and wanted. It is also our responsibility to let them know that we need them. We need to hear their stories. They need to know that without them, we are incomplete.
