Sermon Recap

- Being born is kind of a strange phenomenon. It happens without our consent or cooperation. It is arguably the most amazing moment in our lives, yet it is not a moment any of us can remember.
- The same may be true of our spiritual birth. We might not remember when it happened or even recognize that it is happening; but Christ invites us to be awakened to the work of God’s spirit in our lives so that we can embrace the everlasting life he offers.
- When we embrace our spiritual birth, we are able to move out of the womb and begin to live. We move away from being mere believers of propositional truths to disciples who step out of the night to begin following Jesus.
